There is an organisational commitment to provide professional development opportunities for staff to stay abreast of current practices and increase knowledge and skills.

There are procedures in place to ensure all client advocates undergo training compliant with "Safe Environments for Children and Young People" and are aware of their roles according to the Child Safe Act 2016.

We are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children and children from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds.

We are dedicated to providing a safe, respectful and inclusive service for all children regardless of disability, gender, location or faith.
